



Lenten Mission Project

Our mission project this year is Samaritan's Purse. They are an international evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual Samaritan's I and physical aid to hurting people around the world with the goal of sharing the love



of Jesus Christ. Samaritan's purse was founded on February 25, 1970 by Dr. Bob Pierce, and William Franklin Graham III has been Chairman and President since 1979. Their international headquarters are located in the United States with affiliate offices in five countries, field offices in fifteen, and ministry partners in more than 100 countries. What they do: animals. agriculture & livelihoods; children's programs; construction programs; crisis & disaster relief; discipleship, education & training; feeding programs; health & medical programs; water, sanitation & hygiene; and women's programs.
